European Day of Language

We had a wonderful afternoon on Wednesday afternoon, celebrating European Day of Languages. Mr Wojanek kindly gave up part of his afternoon to come into assembly and tell us about Poland. He told us about a delicious sounding dish that is special to his region; that an eagle wearing a crown is an important Polish symbol and he very patiently taught us how to say the numbers 1-10. Regina then told us that some of the Polish numbers sound very similar to Slovakian ones and Ralfs told us that some sounded similar to Latvian ones so we added a few more numbers to our repertoire! Regina then taught us how to say the numbers 1-10 in Hungarian! She also told us that if you visit Slovakia, you spend Euros and brought some in for us to look at. Mr Wojanek explained Poland doesn't use Euros as its currency but uses złoty.

Regina told us that the rose is an important flower in Slovakia.

This was such a lovely afternoon where our school family could celebrate some of the many nations represented in our school. It was lovely to be taught by adults and children!
