### Run a Mile

As you are aware, we are encouraged to be active and adopt a healthy lifestyle. We talk to the children about the choices they make about their lifestyle.

Being active young, helps people continue a healthy lifestyle into adulthood. Research has proved that exercise is also really good for improving mental health.

Being active also helps concentration. Bearing all this in mind, school has decided that children are going to be encouraged to run a mile a day. At a given point each day, children will be encouraged to run for 15 minutes. Some children won't manage a mile in this time and some will do more - that is fine. We are going to encourage children to measure how far they have run and hopefully after a few sessions they will be able to run further. It's all about children improving on their personal bests.

We will be looking at how far they have run over time and putting it into context e.g. running the distance to Newcastle, London or even abroad!

Please can you ensure children have a pair of suitable PE shoes in school each day for them to change into.
