Areas of Learning

Areas of Learning for 'Ourselves' Autumn 2018 Dragons Class

As **Readers** and **Writers** we will be reading the book 'Orion and the Dark' by Emma Yarlett. Through this and other class texts we will develop our reading skills by predicting what will happen next, clarifying and learning new vocabulary, as well as asking simple question to help us understand the text. In order to help us do this we will be using a range of techniques such as role play and hot seating characters.

Each day we will be looking to improve our knowledge of sounds to help us become confident and independent readers as well as independent writers. Later in the year, the year 1 children will be going through the Phonics Screening Assessment and we will be working with them to ensure they are as confident and capable as possible.

As **Mathematicians**, we will be looking to consolidate our understanding of numbers through a range of practical, mental and written methods. We will then try to apply our understanding to a broad range of problems. We will then look at addition and subtraction using a range of skills.

As **Scientists**, we will be exploring our bodies, looking in particular at naming each part as well as discovering all about our senses. Alongside this we will be investigating the season of Autumn, using our observational skill to discuss the changes around us. Throughout we will endeavour to develop our scientific enquiry skills through investigations.

As **Historians**, we will be looking at how things have changed for the children over their lifetime – toys, clothes and things they can do. As well as investigating modern and old fashioned toys.

As **Geographers**, we will be looking at the countries of the United Kingdom and their capital cities. Alongside this we shall be working on positional language and compass points.

As **Artists**, we will be sketching portraits of our friends as well as completing a self-portrait in colour. We also hope investigate colour by looking at nature during the season of Autumn.

As **Musicians**, we will be introducing the children to 'Charanga Music', an interactive fun scheme. It allows the children to experience a broad range of musical styles, take part in a range of fun activities and expand their repertoire of songs.

As **Designers**, we will be exploring different toy designs before going onto create a toy of our own. Alongside this we will be exploring different materials during junk modelling sessions.

As **ICT specialists**, we will be looking at staying safe online as well introducing the children to a range of digital programs
