range of safety workshops. Their
behaviour was superb and they
were a real credit to the school,
especially as some of the
messages needed a very mature
attitude. Children learnt about
lots of safety aspects including:
the effects of cigarettes, drugs
and alcohol; fire safety within
the house, including how to use
electrical devices safely; the
support of the school nurse in
school when children have
worries; and how to be safe
around water, including what
to do if a friend falls in a river.
