Mr Hodgson (who is the school's maths leader) has asked that a helpful leaflet on ways in which you can support your child's learning in maths be sent home with your child this afternoon. Eagles have really improved in their learning of times tables and division facts and quite surprised themselves when they did their weekly tests this week. There was some great improvements both in how well they had scored (lots of 50/50 and 49/50) and in how quickly they completed them.
