Mathletics

School received an interesting report last week, it looked at how well Mathletics is being used in school. Based on what all pupils did on Mathletics in the Autumn term, cumulatively, children racked up an amazing 337,558 points! That's some going for our small school! On average, children improved by 33% from the first time they tried an activity to their latest attempt. Research suggests that it takes 3 Mathletics activities per week to improve results. Our pupils, on average, attempted 5.43 activities per week! No wonder children are feeling more confident about their mathematical understanding. 15 silver certificates and 82 bronze certificates were awarded! That shows real dedication! The next challenge is: can we improve on these statistics this term? I'm sure we can if every pupils tries hard!
