Tuesday was Safer Internet Day.  
As a school we used the  
resources, which can be found  
online, on the themes "Together  
for a better Internet" and "Our  
internet, Our choice." Dragons  
watched a short, interactive film  
about some children playing a  
space race game online. The  
children had choices to make  
whilst online and we discussed  
the good and bad choices  
available to them and what the  
consequences of their choices  
might be. Eagles discussed what  
the internet is and looked at  
different scenarios as part of a  
game called "Online compass".  
They learnt about online consent  
and the importance of asking for  
adult help when faced with tricky  
choices. If children want to
