Mathletics Competition

In KS1 this week, we have started two new types of learning. We have started our new music topic called 'Hey You!' Our other topic is computing where we are learning to code. So far, we can move objects around the screen as well as give commands for objects to disappear or move when clicked.

In maths, they are investigating number 5 and have enjoyed watching Numberblocks as well as doing lots of activities to help them understand the value of 5.
